



Before you renew your scholarship, consider the following:


- ! The priority deadline for submission of all required renewal documents to the appropriate Gates Millennium Scholars (GMS) Administrative Office is **FRIDAY**, **JULY 22**, **2011**. Failure to meet this deadline will delay GMS funding.
- Scholars who choose to attend institutions that do not participate in **federal financial aid programs** are not eligible for GMS funding.



To be eligible for GMS funding, Scholars must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each academic year and be deemed eligible to receive federal financial aid by their institutions' Financial Aid Offices. All Scholars are urged to file their FAFSA by their institution's priority deadline. Please visit www.fafsa.ed.gov for more information.

! Read the *GMS Administrative Guidelines*, located on the Scholar Website at www.gmsp.org and Scholar Connection at www.gmsconnection.org, to learn more about the requirements of the scholarship.

- ! The **GMS** e-mail icon on the homepage of the Scholar Website provides access to your GMS e-mail account (*gatesscholars.org*).
- You may use your GMS e-mail to exchange messages with the GMS staff and other Gates Millennium Scholars at their GMS e-mail addresses *until* September 30, 2011. Effective October 1, 2011 your GMS e-mail account (gatesscholars.org) will be deactivated. Future correspondence will be sent to your personal e-mail address that you have on file with GMS.

GMS Graduate Funding Guidelines

Special information for current and prospective graduate Scholars

- Capped Awards Any Scholar entering an eligible GMS funded master's or doctoral graduate program (including teacher certificate and Ed.S. programs), will be considered for a graduate fellowship award. The capped graduate fellowships for Academic Year 2011-2012 are not to exceed \$36,122 for private institutions and \$24,892 for public institutions.
- **Graduate Program of Study Eligibility -** To be eligible for GMS funding consideration, graduate Scholars must be degree-seeking students in one of seven GMS-funded disciplines: computer science, education, engineering, library science, mathematics, public health and science.
 - GMS Graduate fellowships will <u>NOT</u> be awarded in the following graduate areas of study: business, humanities, medicine, law, social sciences and theology.
 - Graduate Program Inquiry Since January 2010, all Gates Millennium Scholars entering
 graduate school in one of the seven funded areas of graduate study (listed above) are
 required to submit a Graduate Program Inquiry with supporting documentation before
 starting their desired degree program.



If you have **not** already received prior GMS approval regarding the eligibility of your graduate program for funding consideration, submit the Graduate Program Inquiry Form (GPIF) and supporting documentation **immediately!** The GPIF is currently available for download from the *Forms* section of the Scholar Website (www.gmsp.org) and is also posted on the Scholar Connection's homepage (www.gmsconnection.org).

- Education Specialist Degree (Ed.S.) GMS will consider funding for an Ed.S., which GMS counts toward the maximum 10 academic years of funding allowed.
- Teacher Certificate Programs GMS will consider funding for Teacher Certificate Programs for a maximum
 of one academic year. GMS counts Teacher Certificate funding toward the maximum 10 academic years of
 funding allowed.
- **Summer Funding for Graduate Scholars** Graduate Scholars must meet <u>ALL</u> of the following criteria in order to be considered for summer funding:
 - 1. Active GMS status during the preceding academic year (2011-2012)
 - **EXCEPTION:** If a Scholar is returning from deferment and must take required courses during the summer (i.e., the degree related courses are not offered during any term of the Scholar's remaining eligibility) he/she must submit supporting documentation that explicitly details the availability of the courses. Additionally, the Scholar must submit a written statement that acknowledges the fact that there will be a reduction of his/her GMS award during the subsequent academic year.
 - 2. The GMS capped amount was not depleted during the preceding academic year. The capped graduate fellowship allowance will serve as the maximum allowance for an entire twelve-month period. Graduate Scholars who exhaust the maximum capped amount during the academic year or preceding term of enrollment will not be eligible for summer funding.
 - 3. Summer courses are in the same degree program that was pursued in the preceding academic year (i.e., Scholar is not enrolling into a new program).

IMPORTANT: Unused GMS funding does not carry over to future years.

All required renewal documents must be submitted to the appropriate GMS Administrative Office by the deadline. Failure to meet this deadline will delay GMS funding.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. If I am unable to submit all of my Renewal documents by the July 22nd priority deadline, when will GMS mail my check for the fall term?

GMS sends awards directly to each Scholar's institution on a rolling basis beginning in July. If you do not submit all of the required documents by the priority deadline (i.e., July 22, 2011), determination of your GMS award may be delayed. You can visit the Scholar Website to view the status of your award check or call 1-877-690-GMSP (4677).

2. Do I need to be eligible for the Pell Grant to renew my Gates Millennium Scholars scholarship/awards?

No, Pell Grant eligibility is not a requirement for renewal. However, you must file the FASFA annually. Please do so before your institution's priority deadline or at the earliest possible date.

3. What is the minimum GPA requirement to maintain the GMS award?

To be eligible for GMS funding, you must meet your institution's "satisfactory academic progress" (SAP) standards. Additionally, you must be eligible for federal financial aid as determined by your financial aid office. Your financial aid office will be able to provide you with more information regarding SAP and eligibility for federal financial aid.

4. Should I decline loans that are offered to me?

The GMS Staff cannot advise you on whether or not to decline the educational loans offered on your financial aid award letter. Please contact your financial aid counselor to discuss the matter. In the meantime, submit the financial aid award letter that you have. Scholars are not penalized for having educational loans on their award letters.

5. My financial aid office told me to take out a loan to cover my family contribution (FC). Will GMS cover all of my loans?

GMS awards do not replace Federal Family Contribution (FM FC) or any portion of an educational loan (e.g., PLUS, unsubsidized loan, health professional loan, state loan, institutional loan, private loan) that covers a Scholar's FM FC

6. Will GMS cover my off-campus housing?

The GMS award is based on the information listed on your financial aid award letter and the GMS Information Sheet. Contact your financial aid counselor to discuss your educational expenses (including housing) and your cost of attendance.

7. I am planning to study abroad. Will GMS cover this expense?

GMS funds are available for study abroad and exchange programs that are sponsored by a Scholar's college or university during the fall, winter and/or spring terms and only when the study abroad expenses are incorporated into your financial aid award letter and cost of attendance. You must be eligible to receive federal financial aid through your **home** college or university during the term(s) that you study abroad. GMS does not fund independent study abroad programs or summer study abroad programs.
